This note describes the various sources of international social statistics held in the Library or available online. Detailed sources for the UK are covered in the Library Standard Note *Social statistics: key sources*.¹

The note represents a self-help guide, providing a starting point for people interested in obtaining international statistics for themselves. The sources detailed are not intended to be exhaustive: in each instance, more information should be yielded by further investigation by the user. Contact details of Library staff dealing with different areas of social statistics appear in Section A. Economic statistics are dealt with by the Economic Policy and Statistics Section: contact details can be found in the regular *Economic Indicators* Research Paper which is available from the Library or via the intra- and internet.

Increasingly, data sources are available online. Links to relevant websites and publications are contained within the text of the report, with footnotes detailing the web addresses for hard copy readers in Section F. As far as possible links lead to parent web pages, from which the user can navigate to the specific area they require.

The links in the report lead primarily to English-language versions of national statistical websites. In many instances, the English websites contain less detailed information than the home-language versions and in some cases there is no English translation available. The Library maintains a list of staff with language skills: for assistance with translations please contact Derby Gate Library on x6767.

Where there is no online access, the Library's hard copy holdings are instead detailed.

While at the time of printing all hyperlinks should be current, the fluid nature of online data means that some of these links may from time to time become out of date. If you experience any problems connecting to a document, please inform the Statistics Resource Unit via hclsru@parliament.uk

1. European Union

[Eurostat](#)³ is the statistical office of the European Communities and publishes statistical summaries across a range of subjects at both EU-level and Member State level. The Library has hard copy holdings of many of the Eurostat publications and there are several titles and data series available [free of charge](#)⁴ on the website.

2. OECD

3. UN

The United Nations Statistical Division provides access to a range of international datasets and [publications](#).¹⁵ The [Demographic & Social](#)¹⁶ section of the website provides an introduction to various sources of population and societal wellbeing data. Basic data by country is provided for a range of [social indicators](#),¹⁷ including:

Millennium Development Goals were adopted by the United Nations Secretariat, along with the IMF, OECD and World Bank, in September 2000 as a way of measuring progress towards the objective of freeing the entire human race from want. A total of 48 indicators were chosen to measure progress towards the eight goals and 18 targets. The [Millennium Indicators Database](#)²⁷ details each of the indicators in turn. Alternatively, the performances of [individual countries](#)²⁸ can be monitored.

There is also coverage of [energy](#)²⁹ and [environmental](#)³⁰ statistics.

C. European Union Member States

1. Austria

[Statistics Austria](#)³¹ is the official source of statistics on the economic and social situation in Austria. The [English](#)³² version of the site is less detailed than the original, with basic tables relating to:

Further [statistical](#)³⁷ analysis is provided for subjects including [health](#),³⁸ [education](#),³⁹ [crime](#)⁴⁰ and [social security](#).⁴¹ Topographic and regional data is provided in the [physical facts on Austria](#)⁴² section.

The *[Statistical Yearbook of Austria 2004](#)*⁴³ provides times series summary data for the range of social and economic subjects.

2. Belgium

[Statistics Belgium](#)⁴⁴ is the website of the National Institute of Statistics. While there is an English version, it is somewhat less detailed than the [French](#)⁴⁵ and [Dutch](#)⁴⁶ sites. [Publications](#),⁴⁷ for instance, cannot be downloaded in English.

The English analysis of the [General Socio-Economic Survey](#)⁴⁸ details the history of the Belgian Census since 1846. [Results](#)⁴⁹ from 1970, 1981 and 1991 are tabulated, although the descriptions are provided in French and Dutch only.

The [Country Portal](#)⁵⁰ provides a useful link to a variety of statistical sources for every country in the world.

Copies of *Annuaire de Statistiques Régionales*, Belgium's statistical yearbook, are held in hard copy in the Derby Gate Library.

3. Czech Republic

The [Czech Statistical Office](#)⁵¹ produces releases and [publications](#)⁵² across a variety of subjects, including [2003 summary data](#)⁵³ for the full range of social subjects. Subject-specific releases are grouped as below:

4. Cyprus

The statistical pages for Cyprus can be accessed via the Cypriot government's website. At the time of writing these pages were not available.

The Derby Gate Library holds copies of the Cyprus *Statistical Abstract* for 1965-66, 1991-92 and for more recent years.

5. Denmark

[Statistics Denmark](#)⁶¹ provides a range of statistical information and publications. [StatBank Denmark](#)⁶² is a free database containing detailed statistical information on Denmark and Danish society:

The bulletin is mainly in Estonian but does have some English translations.

7. Finland

[Statistics Finland](#) ⁷⁹ operates under the Ministry of Finance, producing official national statistics and information services. The [statistics](#) ⁸⁰ section provides data on a range of subjects including elections, population, environment and energy, women and men, education, and culture and media.

[WebStat](#) ⁸⁹ is a database of statistical sources available through the internet. The material is organised by subject field and by country. The results contain a description of the source as well as a direct link to it. The database is compiled and maintained by the [Library of Statistics Finland](#). ⁹⁰

8. France

The [National Institute for Statistical and Economical Studies \(INSEE\)](#) ⁹¹ is the official source of statistics in France. At the time of writing, however, the website was prone to some difficulties. Data is also available in hardcopy in the *Annuaire Statistique de la France*; please contact the Library for further information.

*France in Facts and Figures*⁹² contains social statistics on France including:

10. Greece

The homepage of the [General Secretariat of National Statistical Service of Greece](#)¹⁵³ website has information on recent news releases and publications. Statistical holdings for 2003 are contained in the report [Ireland, North and South: A Statistical Profile 2003](#).¹⁹⁴ The report was compiled by the Northern Ireland Statistics and Research Agency (NISRA) and the Central Statistics Office (CSO), to produce comparable statistics for Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland across a range of policy areas.

The website contains details of the [Irish Presidency of the EU Council](#)¹⁹⁵ and provides access to *Measuring Ireland's Progress Volumes 1 and 2, 2003*,¹⁹⁶ a report on the progress made in Ireland in a number of important economic, social and environmental areas.

The [EireStat Spreadsheet Service](#)¹⁹⁷ contains datasets and background information on a range of social themes.

13. Italy

Italy's National Statistical Institute, [IStat](#)¹⁹⁸ is the country's official source of data. The [data bank](#)¹⁹⁹ contains details of:
